

# CREATING MASTERPIECES

## POTTERY CLASS

Students will have the opportunity to explore the art of pottery through a comprehensive course. They will be introduced to the intricate skill of throwing on a potter's wheel, mastering the techniques of hand-building, and creating unique ceramics. Additionally, they will learn how to embellish their creations, experimenting with various textures on clay and using special paints to add vibrant colors. Once students have completed their initial art pieces, they will further expand their skills by crafting a dish using hand-building techniques with clay.



## AH-TAH-THI-KI SEMINOLE INDIAN MUSEUM

The Ah-Tah-Thi-Ki Museum, situated in the heart of the Everglades on the Big Cypress Seminole Indian Reservation, houses over 200,000 works of art and historic objects. During the visit, students will learn about the Seminole people and explore their rich cultural and historical connections to the Southeast and Florida, where they have resided in Big Cypress since its establishment. Following the museum tour, students will discover the art and techniques of a Seminole artist and a Western artist, and then compare and contrast their work. The activity will conclude with students creating art inspired by the Seminole artist.

# TIGERTAIL LAKE RECREATION CENTER

At Tigertail, students will participate in a ropes course, an aqua course challenge, and team-building activities. Students will climb 40-foot towers and reach new heights! Participants will climb and traverse sections of a unique lily pad-style ropes course, conquering fear and feeling the support of their classmates at all times. Safety gear, including a harness and helmet, is provided, and belaying is managed by experienced, certified professional facilitators to ensure the highest level of safety. The Aqua Challenge is a brand-new water obstacle course and playground featuring eight challenging elements. Learning to work together and communicate well are essential skills. Participants will explore the fundamental concepts of teamwork in a fun, lighthearted, but challenging environment through various "games" and initiatives designed to keep them learning.
